<b>Information Sought :</b>	As the information sought closely relates to RRB Section of this Department and PSBs/PSIs/PFIs, the RTI application is being transferred to them under section 6(3) (ii) of the RTI Act, 2005 for providing requisite information directly to the applicant.		
<b>Original RTI Text :</b>	Respected sir/mam, I am speech disabled person and my disability percentage is 50.6%. In the document of department of empowerment of persons with disabilities(page no 64, file no. 16-09/2014-DD-III, dated on 8 July, 2015), hearing and speech disability are considered in one category and their assessment is also considered in same category and speech and language disability is also specified in RPWD ACT,2016. But why in government exams like SSC, RRB, IBPS and many more exams there is no reservation for speech disabled persons.		

And reservation is given only for these categories:

- (a) blindness and low vision
- (b) deaf and hard of hearing
- (c) loco motor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy.
- (d) autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness
- (e) multiple disabilities from amongst persons under clauses (a) to (d) including deaf-blindness in the posts identified for each disabilities.

why is this injustice and discrimination on the basis of disability happening to us? Every person with disabilities has the right to be given equal opportunities and reservation in government sector then why there is no reservation for speech and language disabled persons in government exams.
